Popo Bonfire Night - A Raging Success

Even bigger and better than last year!! – that phrase was heard over and over again.

The **Popanyinning Progress Association** is very pleased with the response and turnout

for its annual event. For the third year running the very talented and versatile band “The Krits” put on a marathon 6 hour performance that had people rocking and dancing right up to midnight.

A large crowd of locals and visitors, estimated at 400, attended the event. Approximately half of these camped on the oval overnight in 74 caravans, camper trailers, and numerous swags laid out next to cars.

The hungry hoard ate their way through 30kgs of roast beef litres of gravy, 200 sausages, and a small mountain of bread rolls. The new and updated version of “Popo Bonfire” stubby holders were put on sale, and the entire stock of 100 was sold out. At one stage people were paying double just to secure one!

The crowd enjoyed a relaxed family event, children were able to play safely in the floodlit tennis courts thanks to the CBH Grassroots funding that was secured in 2021, while the adults relaxed in the warmth of the very large bonfire, or danced to the music of The Krits.

A special thanks must be made to Cuballing Shire Council which provided some financial assistance, staff who built the bonfire, mowed the oval, and provided a marquee and cleaned up the area to make it safe to hold the event.

In 1990 an initial heritage trail was established. The circuit is about 2.4km including the cemetery. Sites/buildings, included in no particular order;



2021 LOCAL GOVERNMENT ELECTIONS

Candidate Nominations are called for the 2021 Local Government Elections for the Shire of Cuballing.

Vacancies

Three vacancies for a four year term as Councillor.

One vacancy for a two year term as Councillor.

Who can nominate?

Any person who

- is an Australian Citizen over the age of 18 years;
- is an elector of the district; and
- is not disqualified under the Local Government Act 1995;

may nominate for council.

When to nominate

Nominations open on Thursday 2nd September 2021 and close at 4.00pm sharp on Thursday 9th September 2021.

Where to nominate

At the Shire of Cuballing Office at 22 Campbell Street, Cuballing.

Nomination Requirements

Nominations must be on the prescribed form that is available from the Shire office.

An \$80 nomination deposit is required. You may pay your deposit in cash or by cheque, bank draft or postal order. If you make appropriate arrangements with the Returning Officer you may be able to pay your deposit by electronic transfer or other means. Nomination deposits are refunded after the election in some circumstances.

Candidates are required to provide a profile of the candidate consisting of no more than 800 characters including spaces. Your profile must include your name, address and contact numbers. The profile must be confined to information about you. It may include a recent passport size photo of your head or head and shoulders. The profile must be or be capable of being printed on a single A4 page.

You must complete an online induction course before you submit your nomination. The course provides information on the role and responsibilities of being a council member, and the rules related to election campaigns. When you register your completion of the course, you will receive a confirmation email with a reference number and date of completion. You must include the reference number and completion date on your nomination form.

If you are unable to personally attend to nominate, an authorised agent can do this on your behalf.

Voting In The Elections

The Shire of Cuballing conducts the election as a voting in person election. Council has appointed the Chief Executive Officer, Gary Sherry, as the Returning Officer for the Shire of Cuballing 2021 Elections

Council will operate polling places at

- the Shire of Cuballing administration Centre at 22 Campbell Street Cuballing; and
 - the Popanyinning Hall, 98 Francis Street Popanyinning;
- from 8am to 6pm on Election Day of Saturday 16th October 2021.

The counting of votes will be completed at the Shire of Cuballing Administration Centre at 22 Campbell Street Cuballing as soon as possible after the polling ceases.

Is voting compulsory?

No. Voting in local government elections is not compulsory in Western Australia.

Is early voting available?

Yes. Early Voting can be completed at the Shire of Cuballing Administration Centre at 22 Campbell Street Cuballing during normal business hours. This will commence as soon as possible after the close of nominations and continue until 4pm Friday 15th October 2021.

Is postal voting available?

Yes. Postal Voting can be completed if electors register with the Shire of Cuballing. Contact the Shire at 08 9883 6031 or enquiries@cuballing.wa.gov.au to obtain an *Application for Postal Voting Papers*.





INTO THE GARDEN — *by Peter Denton*

Yornaning Dam

What a transformation it has been for our local and popular dam site. Over a period of time our local council has carried out revegetation projects to enhance the environment around the dam site. The carpark has been reduced in size and the area cordoned off with bollards. Local native trees and shrubs have been planted by council and local volunteers and these are progressing well. The bulrushes growing in the dam waters are [Baumea articulata,] a native freshwater rush providing habitat for waterfowl, frogs and the native long necked turtle [Chelodina colliei] along with many other aquatic creatures. The dam now is fully charged with good water following our wet winter. Just recently Western Banjo Frogs could be heard calling in the rushes. A wonderful place to visit, with picnic tables and barbecues in place along with extensive playground equipment for the kids [and big kids!] plus a walkway and nature trail for access to wildflowers and woodland birdlife.

Take your camera and binoculars and treat yourself to a wildlife feast.

There they parked on the oval, amongst the already gathered mass of vans, camper, motor homes and swags, all keen to experience the Bonfire night. They were not disappointed with music, the food or the community atmosphere that made it a highlight of their short visit to our region.

Over the four days, the caravaners injected about \$4,000 into the local economy through fees, meals, fuel and personal spending. In return they went home impressed with the hospitality they received from locals, plus what they saw and experienced whilst here.
