Wildflower season is here!


Are you looking to something to do on a nice spring day? How about taking a wildflower walk at one of the wildflower trails in Popanyinning? The trails branch off from the Popanyinning Oval. You will be pleasantly surprise by the wide trails and un touched bush,. Be sure to follow the trail markers and stick to the trails, watch for traffic as you head east cross the highway to pick up the Qujo trail.

If you have already seen the Popanyinning trails then it is time to see Yornaning Dam in all it's glory. Starting at the old tennis courts you will be pleasantly surprised by the abundance of donkey orchids who have made themselves at home amongst the old courts. Be sure to take your bike to test out the mountain bike trails—sign posted for ease of riding.

Take a picnic lunch soak up the sunshine, spot the bird life and fauna then walk the trails surrounding the dam. The trails are signposted with arrows to ensure easy walking, please be sure to stick to the trails. If you venture off the trails your footprint can have more damage then you realise.



Changes to the Local Planning Scheme

The consultation period on Amendment 6 to Shire of reserves within the Shire of Cuballing. Cuballing Local Planning Scheme No 2 has ended, and Council has adopted the changes. The endorsed 2022-23 Firebreak Order amendment will now be forwarded to the WAPC Each year the Shire adopts a fire break order to help which will arrange for approval by the Minister.

WALGA AGM

Australian Local Government The Western Association (WALGA is holding its AGM next • week. Council discussed the policy issues that have been raised for discussion so that the Shire's delegates are prepared to represent Council's views.

South West Native Title Settlement

As part of the South West Native Title Settlement • the State government will be identifying parcels of land that may be included in the land promised as part of that agreement. Land will usually be vacant crown land or unmanaged reserves. Council is invited to comment on any land identified in the

mitigate bush fire risk in the Shire of Cuballing. The firebreak order and related information will be distributed shortly. Important things to note are:

- The new Australian Fire Danger Rating System is in place from 1 September 2022. Details were in last month's Cuby News and more information will be circulated with the Fire Break Notice; and
- Between 1 October and 31 October 2022 is the Restricted Burning Period so a permit will be required for any burning. The Prohibited Burning Period commences on 1 November 2022.



DOG AND CAT RENEWALS 2022/2023

WHERE DO I RENEW OR REGISTER MY DOG/CAT?

Registrations can be completed at the Shire Office during Office hours Monday to Friday. Registration Forms can be collected from the Shire office or emailed if requested. Please remember to bring proof of sterilisation (sterilisation certificate) if sterilised and your pets microchip number. More information regarding pet registration can be found on the Shire of Cuballing Website.

Renewal Notices will be issued at the end of September and will be due on the 31st of October. Payment for the renewal of your dog/cat can be done in person, via direct debit or over the phone.

If you are a Concession Card Holder, you can receive a 50% discount on your animal's registration. Please bring your concession card into the Office when registering your dog/cat.







WHY REGISTER?

Dog owners are required by law to have all dogs over the age of 3 months microchipped and registered with Local Councils. Cat owners are also required by law to have all cats over the age of 6 months sterilised, microchipped and registered with Local Councils. Registrations for both Cats and Dogs are transferable within Western Australia.

Registration Periods are from the 1st of November to the 31st of October each year. The year of renewal will change depending on whether your Dog/Cat has been registered for 1 year, 3 years or Lifetime.

WHAT IF THE CIRCUMSTANCES CHANGE AFTER REGISTRATION?

When you move address, relocate an animal or if your animal sadly passes away, please advise us of these changes. You can contact the Shire Office over the phone on 9883 6031, via email or in person at our Office Building.

Change of animal ownership must be done in writing (either a written letter or email) and sent to the Shire.

Fallen branches were gathered and burned, dead and dying shrubs were removed, healthy shrubs were trimmed, graves were tended, weeds were removed and our historic country cemetery was shown some appreciation.


